### WHICH ARE THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN SOPRANO, CONCERT, TENOR AND BARITONE UKULELES?

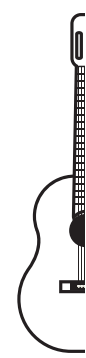

Soprano 21 – traditionally, Soprano is the smallest model among Ukuleles and has a neck with 12 frets. Its tone is the most characteristic of its category. It appeared in the 19th century in Hawaii inspired in the musical instruments brought by the immigrants from Madeira.

Concert 23 – it is an Ukulele with an intermediate size between Soprano and Tenor and it is more comfortable for those with bigger hands. It has a neck with 12 frets and a tone similar to the Soprano. The earliest records of this ukulele date back to the 1920s.

Tenor 26 – it is an Ukulele with an intermediate size between Tenor and Baritone, with a traditional standard tuning and a neck with 17 frets. The volume and sustain are bigger than the Concert and Soprano. It is widely used by musicians, composers of instrumental songs and performers of fingerstyle.

Baritone 30 – it is the biggest Ukulele and it has a neck of 19 frets. The tone, sustain and tuning are different from the others Ukuleles making the instrument a little acoustic guitar with four strings and same tuning.



### STORAGE, DURABILITY AND MAINTENANCE OF YOUR UKULELE:

- Store your UKULELE properly and keep it away from excessive heat, sun and moisture.
- Always keep your instrument clean with a soft, dry cloth;
- Do not use chemicals or abrasives for cleaning;
- Avoid handling your instrument with improper tools. This practice may cause damage.

### WARRANTY

KALANI Ukuleles are warranted in cases of manufacturing defects assuming that they were properly stored and handled.

Warranty against manufacturing defects of ninety days ( 90 days) from the invoice date.

If you need to use the warranty, please go to the place of purchase of your Ukulele with your ticket/receipt/invoice and this warranty certificate.

Your instrument will be sent to our company and we will perform a technical evaluation on it. This warranty excludes all damages caused by misuse, as well as problems caused by drops, malfunctions, improper use, lack of maintenance or repairs carried out by third parties.
